	Milestones en route to delivering key project actions	Progress to date	Learning points to share?
<b>April – June 2004</b>	Monitor and maintain the fluoride milk scheme in the 43 schools taking part in the scheme and promote milk drinking in schools.	Over 2 000 children currently drinking fluoride milk in Sheffield primary schools.	Uncertainty about funding does not allow us to expand the scheme city wide to schools with high caries rates.
<b>July – September 2004</b>	Provide administrative support to schools in the scheme.  Ensure that all children drinking fluoride milk have parents consent and that it s stored in the school file.	Attend intake meetings, health days, parents meetings and school assemblies.	
<b>October - December 2004</b>	To enrol schools into the scheme with high dmft awaiting further information from Dental Public Health regarding dental caries rates in five year olds, so that this information can be given to headteachers to give them an informed choice regarding taking part in the fluoride milk scheme.		

<b>January – March 2005</b>	Continue to provide and distribute updated information regarding fluoride milk to schools and other interested parties.	Termly newsletter published regularly.
